Contributions on other specialized topics, such as monetary growth models and issues of market structure and economic development are also welcome. Papers containing both empirical and theoretical issues will be considered.

### PUBLICATION OF PAPERS:

A subset of the papers will be considered for publication in a proper international journal, subject to the usual review process and approval by the Editorial Board.

### CONFERENCE FEE:

The conference fee is €200, if the payment is received by June 15, 2010. After this date, the fee is €250.
